IAP TNSC has been encouraging its members to promote research and present it within the community. In this regard, Fellow, Life and Associate Life Members of **Tamilnadu and Pondicherry (IAP TNSC)** can present scientific papers during the Annual State Conference. The research work can be presented for the following awards

Dr. V. Balagopala Raju Award	10 min (Presentation) & 5 min (discussion)
Dr. K. A. Krishnamoorthy award	10 min (Presentation) & 5 min (discussion)
Dr. B. R. Santhanakrishnan award - Teaching Institution	8 min (Presentation) & 2 min (discussion)
Dr. B. R. Santhanakrishnan awards - Non Teaching Institution	8 min (Presentation) & 2 min (discussion)
Dr. T. Rajagopal award for "Free papers"	6 min (Presentation) & 2 min (discussion)
E-posters	2 min (Presentation) & 1 min (discussion)

The author and co-authors should be IAP members. Unless specified, at least part of the work should have been done in Tamilnadu or Pondicherry. Presenter shall send a copy of ID proof while submitting the paper for presentation

#### Timeline

- Award Paper Announcement in Newsletter of IAP TNSC minimum of TEN weeks prior to the conference
- Last date for acceptance of research work SIX weeks from the date of announcement (not less than FOUR weeks prior to the conference)
- Announcement of shortlisted papers 2-3 weeks prior to conference
- Submission of PowerPoint presentation at least 3 days before the start of the conference
- Days of Presentation (Can be modified to suit the conference programme)

# **GUIDELINES FOR DR. V. BALAGOPALA RAJU AWARD**

Fellow, Life and Associate Life Members of **Tamilnadu and Pondicherry (IAP TNSC)** can send scientific papers for **Dr. V. Balagopala Raju Award** during the Annual State Conference. The author and co-authors should be IAP members

One award for the best paper (Oral presentation) in 'General Pediatrics including Neonatology' will be given.

The submission should report research in clinical pediatrics including randomized clinical trials, interventional studies, studies of screening and diagnostic tests, cohort and case-control studies, meta-analysis and cost-effectiveness analyses. Descriptive studies, surveys, case records/series, pilot interventional studies, and secondary analyses of data are not preferred.

Studies should meet the following criteria

- Topic has general pediatric interest
- Material is original
- Study methods are ethical and appropriate
- Data are sound
- Conclusions are reasonable and supported by the data
- Manuscript is written in good English.

Each manuscript should be accompanied by an 7-point structured abstract in not more than 300 words. The 7 subheadings of the structured abstract should be:

- 1. Background
- 2. Objectives
- 3. Study design
- 4. Intervention and Outcomes
- 5. Statistical Analysis
- 6. Results
- 7. Conclusion

The main text of the manuscript should be arranged in sections on Introduction, Methods, Results and Discussion. Methods section should always include a sub-heading of 'Statistical analysis.' Key messages should be provided separately at the end of the manuscript. Number of tables and figures should be limited to a maximum of **THREE** and **TWO** respectively. The number of words shall not

exceed 2500 (excluding title page, abstract, tables, figures, acknowledgments, key messages and references should be limited to 25

- The papers should be accompanied by the duly filled submission form. False details furnished will entail rejection of the paper/ poster.
- Only online submission of papers will be accepted.
- Registration for the conference is a must for submission of the paper
- The work for the paper should have been done in Tamil Nadu and Pondicherry only. First author shall be the presenter and should have been a part of the team that had done the work. Presenter should be less than 40 years at the time of presentation. Proof of age should be sent by presenters of shortlisted papers.
- Co-authors of the paper can be more than 40 years of age. In case of non-pediatric specialities, co-authors need not be IAP members. A maximum of FIVE co-authors is allowed for the submitted paper.
- The paper should not have been presented at any other conference, published or sent for publication until the time of the presentation. Three independent judges will be appointed by the Core committee of IAP TNSC to adjudge the submitted papers. The judges will evaluate the papers based on six point criteria, and the maximum marks allotted will be 60 per judge. The top three papers will be shortlisted for oral presentation at the conference. Shortlisted authors will be informed well in advance for presentation in the conference.
- Three independent judges, appointed by the Core committee of IAP will assess the selected papers during the oral presentation. The judges will evaluate the papers based on **eight point** criteria, and the maximum marks allotted will be 40 per judge. The marks of the manuscript and oral presentation will be added and the highest scoring paper shall receive the award. Award may not be given if the papers do not meet adequate standards, and this decision shall be made by the judges of the oral presentation.
- Each presenter will be given **TEN** minutes for presentation and will have **FIVE** minutes for discussion. Questions will be only from the judges and will be answered by the presenter only.
- The presenter of victorious paper will be given a medal and certificate. Co-authors will be given certificates only. Presenters and Co-authors of the other papers selected for oral presentation will be given runner-up certificates.
- The participants, who have not been selected for the Oral presentation (authors and co authors) will receive e-certificates only.

Fellow, Life and Associate Life Members of **Tamilnadu and Pondicherry (IAP TNSC)** can send scientific papers for **Dr. K. A. Krishnamoorthy award** during the Annual State Conference. The author and co-authors should be IAP members.

One award for the best paper (Oral presentation) in "Social (Community) Paediatrics" will be given.

The submission should report research in clinical pediatrics including randomized clinical trials, interventional studies, studies of screening and diagnostic tests, cohort and case-control studies, meta-analysis and cost-effectiveness analyses. Descriptive studies, surveys, case records/series, pilot interventional studies, and secondary analyses of data are not preferred.

Studies should meet the following criteria

- Topic has general pediatric interest
- Material is original
- Study methods are ethical and appropriate
- Data are sound
- Conclusions are reasonable and supported by the data
- Manuscript is written in good English.

Each manuscript should be accompanied by an 7-point structured abstract in not more than 300 words. The 7 subheadings of the structured abstract should be:

Fellow, Life and Associate Life Members of **Tamilnadu and Pondicherry (IAP TNSC)** can send scientific papers for **Dr. B. R. Santhanakrishnan awards - Teaching Institution & Non-Teaching Institution** during the Annual State Conference. The author and co-authors should be IAP members

A total of **TWO** awards, one to the best paper from the **Teaching Institution** and the other one to the best from **Non-Teaching Institution in 'General Paediatrics including Neonatology' will be given**.

The submission should report research in clinical pediatrics including randomized clinical trials, interventional studies, studies of screening and diagnostic tests, cohort and case-control studies, meta-analysis and cost-effectiveness analyses. Descriptive studies, surveys, case records/series, pilot interventional studies, and secondary analyses of data are not preferred.

Studies should meet the following criteria

- Topic has general pediatric interest
- Material is original
- Study methods are ethical and appropriate
- Data are sound
- Conclusions are reasonable and supported by the data
- Manuscript is written in good English.

Fellow, Life and Associate Life Members of **Tamilnadu and Pondicherry (IAP TNSC)** can send scientific papers for **Dr. T. Rajagopal Award** during the Annual State Conference. The Dr. T. Rajagopal award is for open paper in 'General Paediatrics including Neonatology'. The author and co-authors should be IAP members

The submission should report research in clinical pediatrics including randomized clinical trials, interventional studies, studies of screening and diagnostic tests, cohort and case-control studies, meta-analysis and cost-effectiveness analyses. Descriptive studies, surveys, case records/series, pilot interventional studies, and secondary analyses of data are not preferred.

Studies should meet the following criteria

- Topic has general pediatric interest
- Material is original
- Study methods are ethical and appropriate
- Data are sound
- Conclusions are reasonable and supported by the data
- Manuscript is written in good English.

Each submission should be a 7-point structured abstract in not more than 300 words. The 7 subheadings of the structured abstract should be:

- 1. Background
- 2. Objectives
- 3. Study design
- 4. Intervention and Outcomes
- 5. Statistical Analysis
- 6. Results
- 7. Conclusion

The papers should be accompanied by the duly filled submission form. False details furnished will entail rejection of the paper/ poster.

- Only online submission of papers will be accepted.
- Registration for the conference is a must for submission of the paper

- The work for the paper should have been done in Tamil Nadu and Pondicherry only. First author shall be the presenter and should have been a part of the team that had done the work and there is no age limit for the presenters. In case of non-pediatric specialities, co-authors need not be IAP members. A maximum of FIVE co-authors is allowed for the submitted paper.
- The paper should not have been presented at any other conference, published or sent for publication until the time of the presentation. **Three independent judges** will be appointed by the **Core committee of IAP TNSC** to adjudge the abstracts of the submitted papers. The judges will evaluate the papers based on Eight point criteria, and the maximum marks allotted will be 40 per judge. The top TEN papers will be eligible for oral presentation at the conference. Shortlisted authors will be informed well in advance for presentation in the conference.
- Assessment for write-ups will not be considered for awarding gold medal and certificate, except to decide the top ten papers for oral presentation from the papers submitted under this category.
- Each presenter will be given **SIX** minutes for presentation and will have **TWO** minutes for discussion. Questions can be from floor also and answer can be by the presenter and/or Co-authors.
- Three independent judges for oral presentation, appointed by the Core committee of IAP will assess the selected papers during the oral presentation. The judges will evaluate the papers based on Eight point criteria, and the maximum marks allotted will be 40 per judge. Award may not be given if the qualities of the papers are inadequate.
- The winner of the award will be given a medal and merit certificate. Co-authors will be given certificate only. Other presenters (who are selected for oral presentation of the paper) will be given the participation certificates.
- The participants, who have not been selected for the Oral presentation (authors and co authors) will receive e-certificates only.
- Submissions without the duly filled form / sent later than the cut off date will be summarily rejected.
